City Office



The present city office building was established in 1974 as a base for local administration. Efforts are being made to upgrade the living standards of the citizens and to develop both social and economic improvements.

Life in the City

In Hanyu, there are many public facilities that enables the citizens to enjoy and lead a secure, fulfilling life. This section introduces a few of these facilities that play a part in the daily lives of citizens.

Citizens' Plaza



This facility is equipped with a variety of facilities where people of all ages can gather, relax, or learn. It offers various training courses such as textile dyeing and there are workshops which citizens can rent. It also has an area where photos and various information related to Inaka Sensei are exhibited. Furthermore, facilities such as a personal computer room, an audio-visual room, a multipurpose room, and general training rooms are available.

City Gymnasium



Citizens of Hanyu can enjoy playing volleyball, basketball, badminton, table tennis and handball. There are also facilities for practicing gymnastics, judo, and kendo as well as areas for weight training and for infants to exercise. The gymnasium is also the place to make reservations or inquire about the various sports facilities in Chuo Park.

Kiyasse Hanyu




Kiyasse Hanyu was opened in 2001 as a new facility for agriculture aiming to become the main site for exchange between the people in the urban area and farm area. Many people come from in and out of Hanyu city every day to this facility that sells local products and has a restaurant that offers four types of locally-brewed beer.

Purple Hanyu



This facility was established in order to promote welfare and to upgrade the social status of women as part of the city's aim for equality in the community. The facility offers various lectures and it also can be used for group activities.

Library & leference Hall



The city library acts as a multipurpose study center for the citizens with approximately 170,000 books along with study halls, an audio-visual room and equipment. Furthermore, there is a local reference hall that preserves, investigates, maintains, and exhibits valuable reference materials that convey the history of the local area.

Workhills Hanyu




This facility was established by Hanyu city in collaboration with the Employment Promotion Project Corporation and is open to the general public. In addition to conferences and training courses, it has facilities for lectures, receptions, and indoor sports.

Recycle Center



The Recycle Center aims to decrease the amount of waste and use resources effectively. It has a recycle shop commissioned by the city to sell items such as clothes and other daily necessities at a low price that were lying unused in people's homes.

industrial and Cultural Hall




Concerts, plays, and presentations are some of the activities that are held in the main hall (1286 seats) and sub hall (402 seats) of the Industrial and Cultural Hall. There are also changing rooms, Japanese-style rooms, and conference rooms. It is the main facility for cultural activities in the city.

Health Center



The Health Center maintains close contact with the people of the community. It offers services such as infant health checks, prenatal and post-natal support classes, general health checks, cancer screening, high blood pressure support classes, and vaccination programs.

Community Center



Provided with a multipurpose hall, conference rooms, a room for cooking lessons, tatami rooms, and an audio-visual room, the Chuo Community Center is used for various types of training and group activities. There are a total of nine community centers in Hanyu.
